






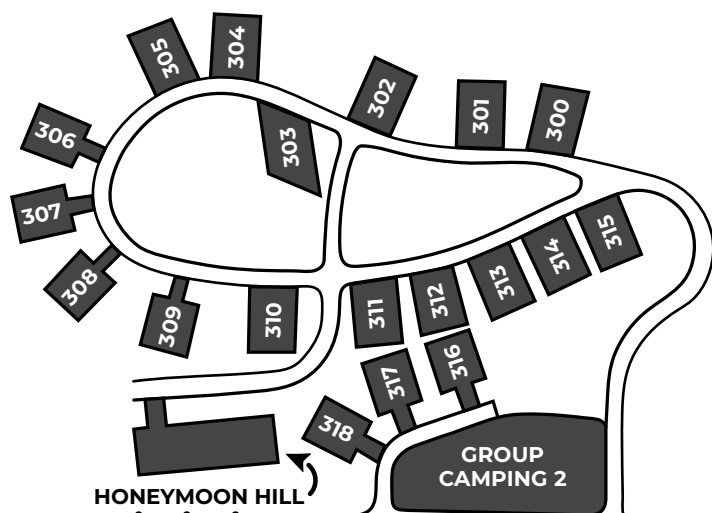

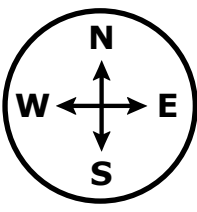

# ✓ CAMPGROUND STANDARDS

## RENTS

All rents must be paid in advance. Weekly and monthly rate available at initial registration only. Sorry, no retroactive rates. No refunds for early check-out.

## CHECK-IN / CHECK-OUT

Check-out is at noon and check-in is at 1 p.m.; please check-out at the office before leaving. Register for an additional night by 6 p.m. the night prior [based on availability.]

## RESERVATIONS

We do our best to honor site requests, but reserve the right to re-assign sites as needed.

## MOVING SITES

Permission from the office is required prior to moving to a new site.

## SITE LIMITS

One camping unit and small tent per site. Six people or one family, please.

## FISH CLEANING

Fish cleaning facilities are located near the marina.

## LIABILITY

We shall not be liable for any loss, theft, injury or damage that may result to any person or property by or from any cause whatsoever.

## SHHH

Quiet Time 10 p.m. - 8 a.m.

## KEEP IT NATURAL

Please, no site alterations. No pesticides or herbicides.

## PARKING

Units must park in campsite as site is designed.

## LP TANKS

All LP tanks must be secured.

## AGE MINIMUM

If you are under 18, you must camp with a parent/guardian.

## SLOW DOWN

Drive 5-10 mph, we want everyone safe and sound.

## GRAY WATER

Dumping gray water on the ground is not allowed.

## SEWER RINGS

Sewer rings are required and are sold at the office.

## TIDY

Keep campsites clean. Your neighbors are nearby, so keep a clean, orderly site and leave it in good condition upon your departure.

## LONG STAYS

All nightly sites have a 2 week limit on occupancy.

## 1ST COME, 1ST SERVED

Non-reservable sites available on a first-come, first-served basis. In fairness to all, no saving or holding sites for others.

## TENT SITES

No generators allowed on primitive, tent sites. Tents, pop-up campers, pick-up campers and small vans are allowed.

## GEESE AND GULLS

Don't feed the birds. If they've made a mess at your site, we have shovels and rakes for clean-up.

## WHERE TO BIKE

Use caution when biking, skating or boarding in the park. Traffic can be heavy and tight spaces can reduce visibility. We recommend using the paved Gitchi Gami State Bike Trail.

## DRIVERS & VEHICLES

All non-licensed electric and gas powered vehicles [scooters, mini-bikes, etc] are prohibited in the park. Licensed drivers & vehicles only.

## NO COLLECTING

Take only photos. Leave only footprints.

## CLOTHESLINE

Use the clotheslines next to Bathhouse 3. In your campsite, a small line under an awing is fine.

## RECYCLING

Please recycle! We have recycle bins at Bathhouses 1, 3, 4 and in the garage next to the office, where we also recycle cardboard. Our local recycle center is also open Monday-Friday afternoons and Saturday mid to late mornings, it is located one mile up the Gunflint Trail.

## PETS

- ◆ You must clean up ALL dog poop, baggies are located throughout the park and at the office.
- ◆ Dogs must be leashed at all times, on leashes that are six feet or less.
- ◆ Pets may never be left unattended.
- ◆ Pets must be kept quiet.
- ◆ If walking your dog, keep out of all campsites except your own.

## FIRE AND FIREWOOD

- ◆ Fires are only allowed in the available grills, must be attended and must be cold when site is unoccupied.
- ◆ No outside wood unless it's local or certified.
- ◆ Purchase wood from us at the office. No cutting, chopping or bark peeling any trees or branches, whether the tree is dead or alive.
- ◆ No beach fires.

## REC HALL AND PAVILION

We are happy to provide our Rec Hall and Pavilion for get-togethers and groups. Make reservations [date and time] at the office.

## WIFI

Limited free WiFi is available at the office on the network "Park Office" and the password is **goskiprocks**.
